Supervisions

There will be regular supervisions for staff with their manager. Twice yearly for 1-1 meetings and yearly supervision meetings. Supervision will identify any gaps in knowledge or skills and appropriate training will be arranged. The staff member can share any difficulties or concerns they have with training.

Volunteers will also be offered a meeting depending on the length of time they are with us.

Appraisal

All staff will have a yearly appraisal. The appraisal will highlight areas of strength, as well as those for development. The aim of the appraisal is to help maintain motivation, support the development of skills and experience and continue to improve performance.

Recognise success and achievements

Allow the staff member to share ideas and concerns

Allow the staff member and manager to reflect on practice in terms of performing the job role and adhering to policies and procedures



Identify developmental needs and training opportunities
