Speech and language

We as a preschool focus a lot on speech, communication and language. Children need adults to help nurture, support and encourage this at home. You can:-

 \cdot Play with your child/children. Follow their lead and build language. Thinking skills helps them to learn and grow.

 \cdot When out and about, talk about the things around you, asking simple questions, what can you see?

- \cdot Give children time to process what has been said to them
- \cdot Repeat back if they are unsure of what has been said
- · Try not to correct them, they are learning and this can have an impact on their confidence.
- \cdot Have fun with words, stories, songs and rhymes.

Staff are always on hand to help with any questions you might have regarding speech, language and communication.

We hope these tips and ideas help with learning at home. If you would like advice on anything, we will do our best to help and support you.
